




Adobe Indesign

In general tab You should choose {Press Quality} preset and compatibility with 4 PDF Acrobat version



In compression tab is recommended not to use compression or use ZIP compression if file is too "heavy" (too high resolution)






In mark and bleed tab choose 3-5 mm bleeds and crop marks are recommended.

!Bleeds are continuously design or color over the cutline (look at the attached picture in last page)


If there is RGB Colors in working file and you choose conversion to CMYK using some profile (any suitable for chosen print material), choose "Convert to Destination (Preserve Numbers)" in color conversion tab.




Or choose "No Conversions, if the file is in CMYK colors already

In any option choose "Don't Include Profiles"

If Spot colours needs to be converted to CMYK- it is possible to do it in Ink Manager at Output tab



At the Advanced option tab choose "High Quality" Transparency flattening
