



#### **BLEED**

A bleed is required when a graphical object (image, text or background) spreads to the edge of your page. Bleed must bee at least 3 mm. All objects at the edge of the page must have bleed.









## Examples of bleed










# ALL objects at the edge must have bleed!











#### **SAFE DESIGN AREA**

Text and any important objects must bee at least 3 mm from page edge, diecut, perforation or punching line.























### 2. Not all objects have bleed








### PAGE LAYOUT SPECIAL CASES



#### **Glued cover**

In case of glued cover, safe area starts 10 mm from inside edge between cover and page.



### Wire-O binding

In case punching, safe area is 11 mm from page edge or 3 mm from punch
